20" Log Cabin Pillow with Button Closure

Join Cathy for a great day of quilting and home décor work – turn your log cabin blocks into a functional pillow – and conquer your fear of buttonholes!

WHAT TO BRING

- 20" pillow form
- Fabric: 6 fabrics for log cabin blocks
 - Fabric for the 4 centre squares
 - Very Light (fat eighth)
 - Light (fat eighth)
 - Medium (fat eighth)
 - Dark (fat quarter)
 - Popper (fat eighth)
- From these fabrics, choose which ones will also be the:
 - Binding (1/4 meter),
 - Back (one piece-13" X 20 1/2" and one-19" X 20 1/2"),
 - Also, one more piece of fabric for the inside, to quilt the log cabins on 22" X 22"
- Batting 80/20, or any other flat batting, one piece 22" X 22"
- 2 pieces of Appliquik, or another fusible interfacing, 3" X Width of the Appliquik (approx 19 3/4") (Can be purchased at workshop)
- 5 Buttons –1 1/8" each
- Cutting Board, Ruler, and Rotary Cutter, Sewing Machine, with regular sewing foot, quilting foot, and buttonhole foot, plus threads to match fabrics (*Please also bring your manual for your sewing machine, if you are not sure about making buttonholes and we will do it together.*) Also bring a small piece of fabric to practice on.
- Hand sewing needle and thread to sew on the buttons, although they can be sewn on by hand.
