8 - 9" x 6" (A1 and B1)

### Dark fabric

4 - 9" x 5" (A2 and B2)

### Light fabric

4 - 9" x 5" (A3 and B3)

Print out the paper piecing pattern (on page 3). You will need to make 4 of each section (A & B) for a total of 8 pieces. Don't forget to **add the 1/4 inch seam allowance** to the patterns.

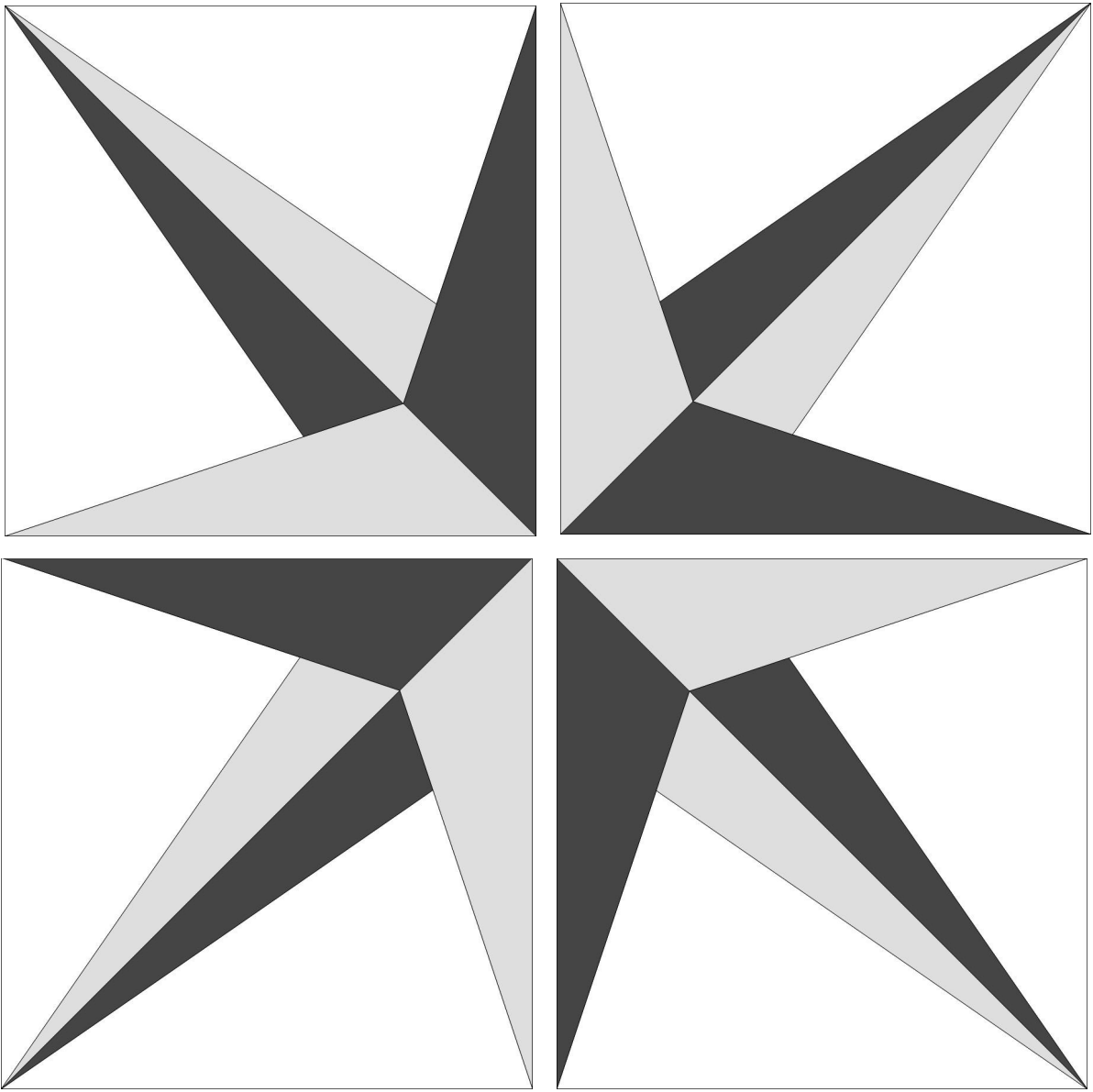
Feel free to use your favorite paper piecing method or use a method from the websites linked below.
