

Low Road - Center Block - September

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Cutting Instructions

Background

16 - 2 1/2" squares

10 - 3" squares*

Dark fabric

8 - 2 1/2" squares

16 - 3" squares*

Medium fabric

4 - 2 1/2" squares

2 - 3" squares*

Light fabric

8 - 3" squares*

- the 3" squares are slightly oversized.

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Piecing Instructions

Making the half square triangles (referred to as HSTs):

Match up the following 3" squares (right sides together):

8 - background and dark (this will yield 16 HSTs)

8 - light and dark (this will yield 16 HSTs)

2 - background and medium (this will yield 4 HSTs)

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the top square and sew a 1/4" away from either side of the line. Cut along the line and trim to 2 1/2".

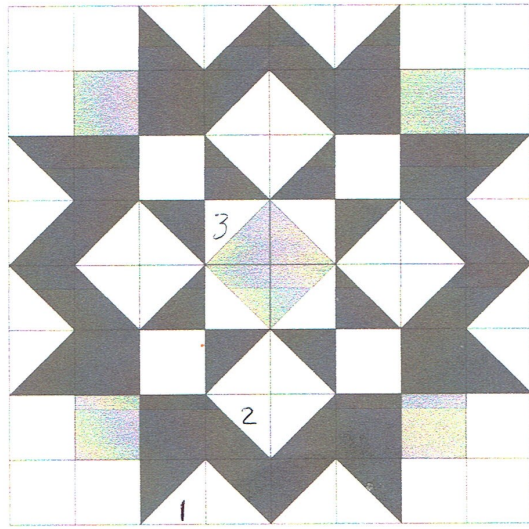

Using the diagram on the following page as a guide, join the pieces together in rows and then join the rows. The final block should measure 16 1/2" (unfinished). As this block is achieved by the strategic placement of value/contrast of fabric, please use the chart on the next page to assist you.



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
