Background fabric

16 - 12" squares

Feature fabric

Many 1" strips of varying lengths (use wider or slimmer strips if you want)

Pick=Up Sticks Instructions

This is an improvisational block (improv) so each one should be slightly different. Basically, slice through your 12" block and insert a 1" strip and sew it back together. Repeat 2 or 3 times (maybe even 4 times). There is no wrong way of making these blocks. This block is also called "slice & dice" using the second link listed below.

You will make 16 blocks - trim them up to a finished 8" (8 1/2 unfinished).
