

# Low Road - February

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## Double Pinwheel Block

### Background Fabric

48 - 3 1/4" squares (sub cut twice on the diagonal to make 4 triangles)

### Dark and Medium Fabric

96 - 3 3/8" (3 1/2") squares (sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles)

### Light Fabrics

48 - 3 1/4" squares (sub cut twice on the diagonal to make 4 triangles)

If you are feeling adventurous, you could switch the background and coloured fabric for a totally different look.

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## Classic Pinwheel Block

### Background Fabric

96 - 4 7/8" squares - draw a diagonal line on each

### Dark, Medium and Light Fabrics

96 - 4 7/8" squares

Match up a background square with a coloured square. Sew on each side of the diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line. Press. Trim up to 2 1/2". This will yield 192 half square triangles. As shown on the next page, sew 4 half square triangles together to create the pinwheel. You will make 48 pinwheel blocks.

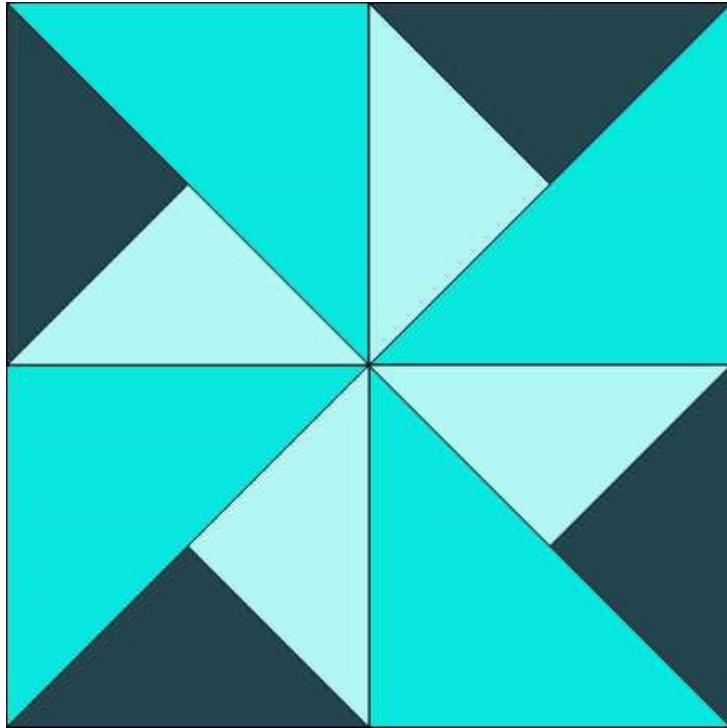
