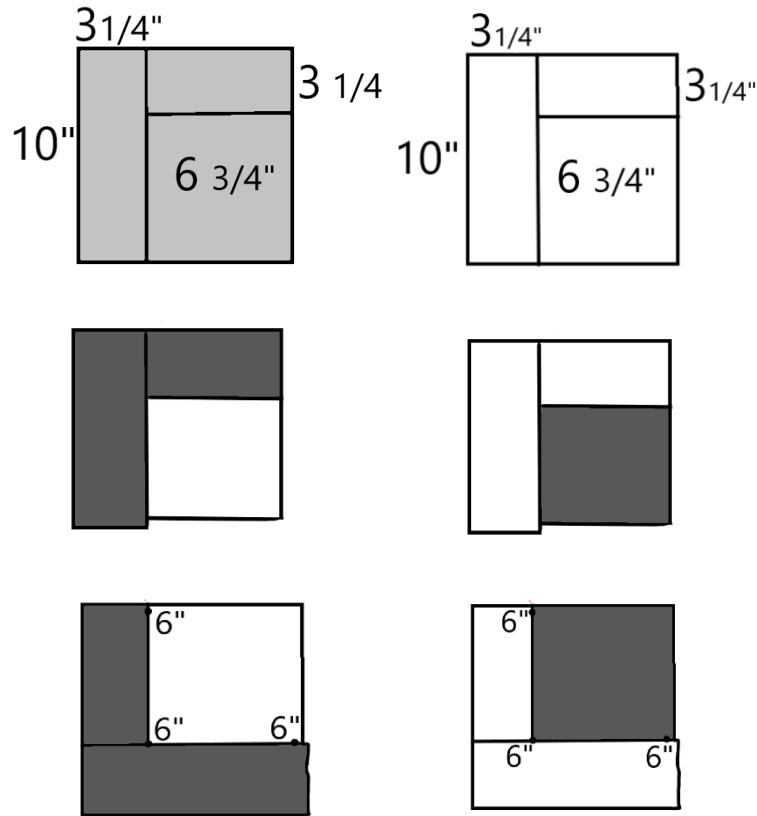


# Illusion Quilt Block

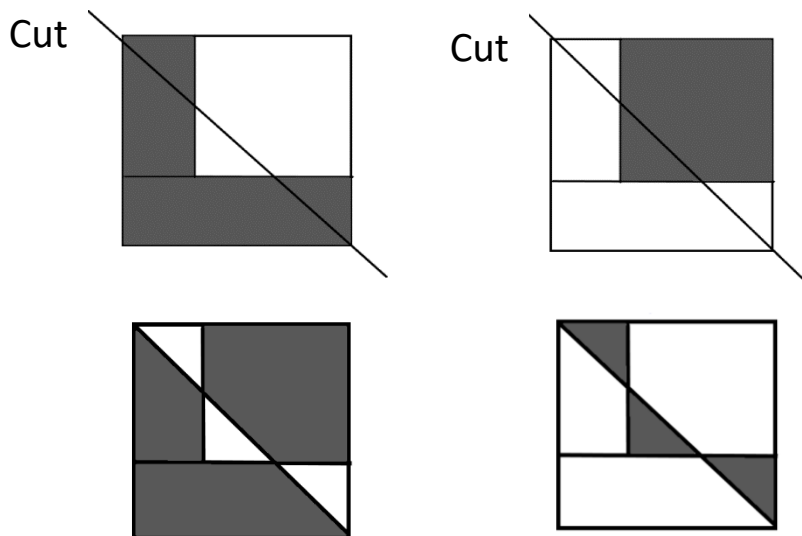


Blocks are made in pairs, dark and light, with scrappy or planned fabrics. Aim for good contrast. Individual block pieces may be cut but instructions are for easy cutting of a 10" square.

Seams are a SCANT  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pressed towards the dark, except diagonal seam.

Sew short seam first, then long seam, matching fabrics at one end.

Place ruler's 6" markings on intersections as shown and trim excess top and side. Rotate block and complete trimming to 9" square.



Triangles will NOT match along seam when sewing together. Press seam open. Lay diagonal line of ruler with seam and trim scant  $\frac{1}{8}$ " around block to measure  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Layout options are endless! Start with Four-Patch circles!

Layout  $6 \times 8 = 48" \times 64"$

Layout  $8 \times 10 = 64" \times 80"$
