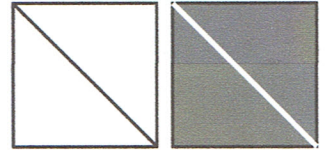


Merry Mayhem's Case #120

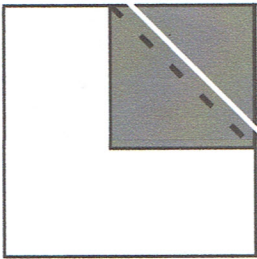
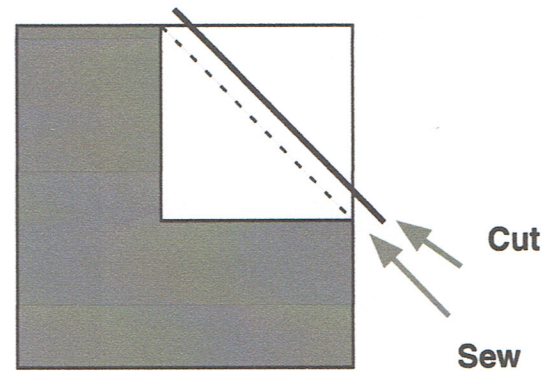
PART 3:

Go back and sort through your sets of Half-Square Triangle units you just made, and match up the Light and Dark fabrics in those units with one each of your remaining 4 1/2" and 2 1/2" Light and Dark squares. In other words, each of the sets of EIGHT Half-Square Triangles you made has ONE Light and ONE Dark fabric; you will go back through your 4 1/2" and 2 1/2" squares and find ONE Light 4 1/2" square and ONE Light 2 1/2" square to match the Light fabric in that set of Half-Square Triangles. You will also go through your 4 1/2" and 2 1/2" squares and find ONE Dark 4 1/2" square and ONE Dark 2 1/2" square to match the Dark fabric in that set of Half-Square Triangles.

Keeping each set of fabrics in separate stacks, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of your 2 1/2" squares.



Next, from each set of fabrics, layer ONE of your 2 1/2" Light Squares on top of ONE of your 4 1/2" Dark Squares, matching up the raw edges in one corner as shown at right. Sew on the line you drew. Then cut the excess fabric in the corner 1/4" away from your seam, as shown below. Press the inner triangle shape back so it is even with the original corner.



Repeat this process with ALL of your 4 1/2" and 2 1/2" squares, matching up Lights with Darks and Darks with Lights. Return these units to their original stacks with their matching Lights and Darks in the Half-Square Triangles.
