## **Cutting Instructions**

## <u>Background</u>

16 - 21/2" squares

10 - 3" squares\*

#### Medium fabric

4 - 2 1/2" squares

2 - 3" squares\*

## Dark fabric

8 - 21/2" squares

16 - 3" squares\*

## Light fabric

8 - 3" squares\*

• the 3" squares are slightly oversized.

# <u>Piecing Instructions</u>

Making the half square triangles (referred to as HSTs):

Match up the following 3" squares (right sides together):

- 8 background and dark (this will yield 16 HSTs)
- 8 light and dark (this will yield 16 HSTs)
- 2 background and medium (this will yield 4 HSTs)

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the top square and sew a 1/4" away from either side of the line. Cut along the line and trim to 2 1/2".


