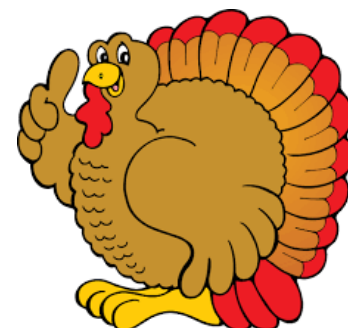

Hi Everyone

A big Thank you to all of our Guild members, at the September meeting we received 85 cuddle quilts, 9 wheelchair quilts, 9 children's quilts and 27 adult quilts. All the donations have been delivered to our various clients . We also received 6 pieced tops.

Please drop by our table, to see our wonderful selection of kits of various sizes and colours. We have kits for tops that need to be pieced and tops that require quilting. The kits for tops have a pattern and enough fabric to make the top. In the kits that require quilting, batting, backing and binding are included.

Please remember that we have a "contest" this year - the following is a reminder of the "Contest guidelines":

1. An early bird draw will be held in December for the completed quilts/ tops we will have by received then.
2. For each quilt/ top completed your name will be put in the draw (those submitted before December will be in both the early bird and final draws).
3. There will be 3 cash prizes in both December and June.

As a reminder to all, the following are the preferred quilt sizes:

- Cuddle quilts – 22" square
- Children/adult (age 5 to young teenage) – anywhere from 40"x40" up to 60"x72" (older teens can be tall)
- Adult - Twin sizes "60" x 75" would be appreciated as many of our organizations have single beds.
- Wheelchair quilts – 36"x36 up to 40"x40"
- Comfort Quilts – 45" x 60" – Flannel both front and back with batting.

The Accuquilt is available for you to use whenever the guild is using the NDC Community Hall. If we are hosting a quilting event (Retreat, Sew Day, or Workshop), guild members are welcome to come use the cutter and dies. The cutter and dies are only available at the hall, the equipment is kept on site.

It will be available at the next **Sew Day**. Plan ahead to do some mega-cutting.

Just walk in and ask. Be prepared to show your guild membership card. If you have never used the system before, ask for guidance.

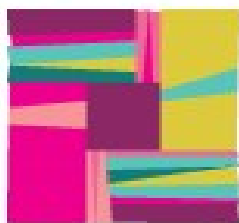

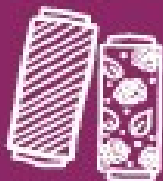

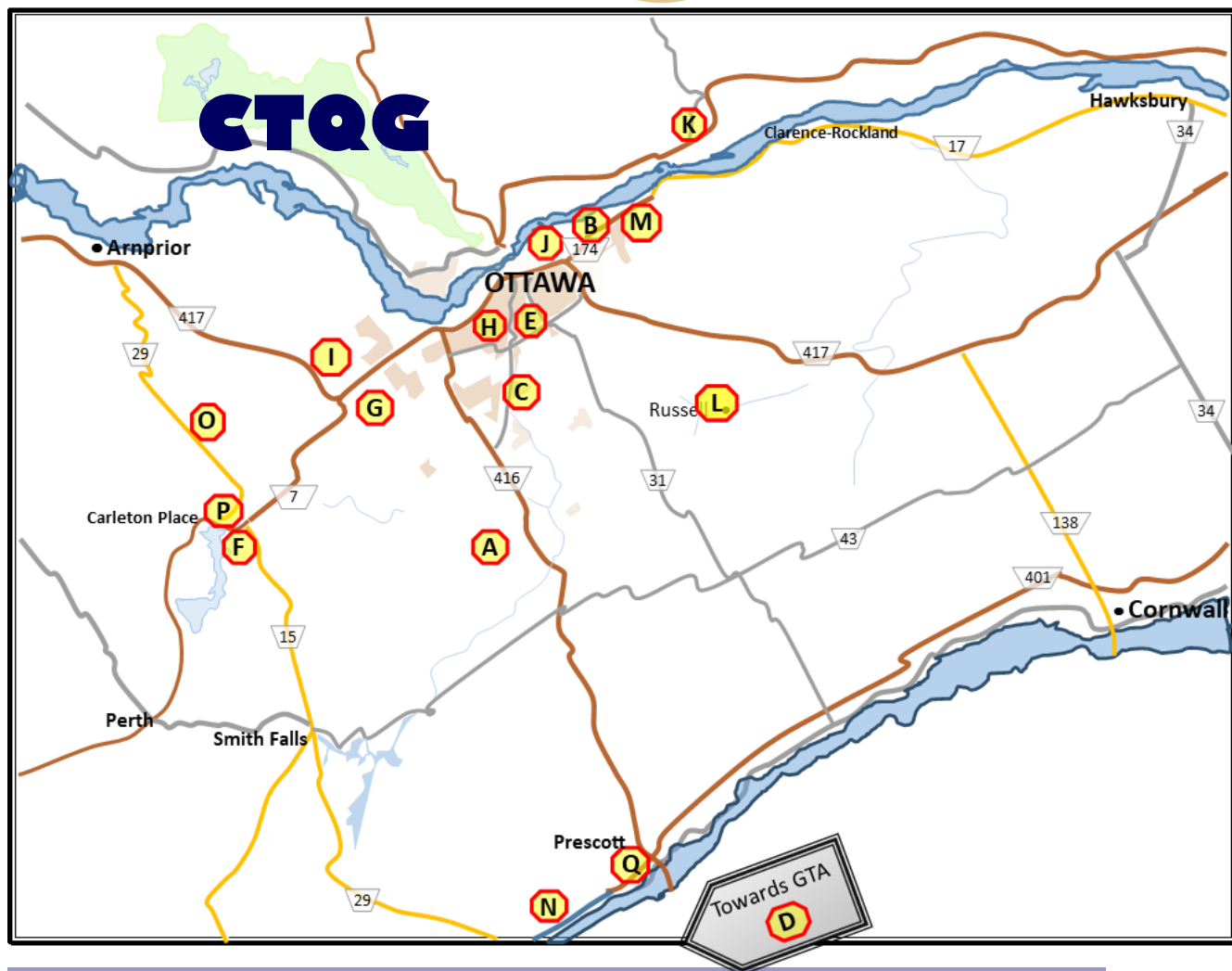
